

Minors 10 Ground Rules

Spring 2018

- Managers must submit their game scores and pitch counts through the link provided within 24 hours of the end of game.
- No new inning shall start after one hour and 45 minutes of total playing time or six innings whichever comes first. All regular season games shall have a two hour drop dead time limit. There will be no drop dead time limit in the playoffs.
- Team managers and coaches shall keep the game moving. Umpires have been directed to adhere to Little League rules regarding warm up pitches and time in between innings. Deliberate delay of the game is unsportmanlike behavior.
- This division utilizes the 5 run limit rule. Therefore, Little League rule 4.10(c) will not apply. Teams shall continue to play up to the allowable time limits set forth above in the 2018 Atlee Little League Local Ground Rules.
- No game shall be subject to a time limit until it is considered a complete game under Little League rules.
- Teams shall not conduct infield practice before the start of the game. Practice will be allowed outside of the white lines and outfield.
- Teams shall use a continuous batting lineup.
- All players shall play in the field at least every other inning. A minimum of one inning of infield shall be played
- The infield fly rule will be in effect for minors 10 baseball
- All catchers mask must have dangling throat guards
- All batting helmets shall have facemasks
- Male players are required to wear a protective cup
- There are no forfeits allowed in Little League. A common player pool will be maintained by the division director. If for some reason you do not have enough players, please contact your division director. Teams will not be allowed to pick and choose who their subs are.
- All substitute players shall play in the outfield and bat last.
- Reschedule Requests: These requests must be sent to your division director. Only valid legitimate reasons will be accepted. The requests must be approved by the division director, vice president of baseball and league president.
- Rules not covered here will be governed by the 2018 Little League Rules and Regulations (Green Book)
