Brian O'Connor – Head Coach

After leading the Virginia baseball program to its first NCAA Championship in 2015, five-time ACC Coach of the Year and three-time National Coach of the Year, Brian O'Connor reached yet another level of success with the Cavaliers. Now in his 15th season as head coach of the Cavaliers, O'Connor has built his program into a college baseball powerhouse. During his tenure the numbers are staggering; 2015 National Champions, 4 CWS appearances and two final CWS Finals berths, 14 straight NCAA tournament appearances, two ACC Championships, four 50-win seasons and 639 wins, including an NCAA-2nd best 423 wins in this decade. Seventy-five of O'Connor's Virginia players have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, including 48 in the last eight years.



Kevin McMullan – Associate Head Coach

Kevin McMullan has a wealth of experience at both the collegiate and professional levels. McMullan enters his 15th season at Virginia. During the 2009 campaign he was named National Assistant Coach of the Year. McMullan has coached over 80 players that have signed professionally including 41 players at Virginia that have gone on to the professional ranks. In 2017, eleven former Cavalier players were playing at the Major League Level. While at Virginia, McMullan's offensive teams have led the ACC numerous times in major offensive categories. His work with the offense has re-written the Cavalier Team Record Books. He serves as Virginia's Recruiting Coordinator, bringing in the Top Recruiting Classes in the Country. McMullan serves as the Hitting Coach and works defensively with the Cavalier position players.



Karl Kuhn – Assistant Coach

Karl Kuhn enters his 15th season at Virginia where he serves as the Pitching Coach. His staffs have led the ACC in team earned run average (ERA) six times and have the second best ERA in Division I baseball from 2005-2017. Kuhn's pitching staff finished first in 2011 and second in 2014 in ERA. During his time at UVA, 38 pitchers have gone on to play at the professional level. Five former Cavalier pitchers have pitched at the Major League Level in the last three seasons. Kuhn was named the National Pitching Coach of the Year in 2014.



Matt Kirby – Volunteer Assistant Coach

Matt Kirby enters his seventh year at Virginia. During Kirby's tenure Virginia has advanced to five NCAA tournaments, winning three regional championships and advancing to the CWS in 2014 and 2015. Kirby's primary duties include assisting with the day-to-day development of position players, coaching the outfielders and coaching first base. Kirby is the director of Virginia's Baseball Camps and continues to grow them into one of the premier camps in the country.

The Camps

High School Prospect Camp

Open to rising 9th-12th-graders in high school, these camps offer ballplayers with a desire to play at the highest level of college baseball an opportunity to be instructed by and compete in front of the University of Virginia coaching staff and other college coaches. These camps continue to draw players from across the country and have gained a great reputation for the structured instruction that is provided. A college skills workout will be held the first night, complete with batting practice, a defensive evaluation, and 60 yard dash. Detailed instruction in all phases of the game will take place each night, along with live games to apply the information and showcase ability through competition. These camps are filled by position to ensure everyone gets equal playing time during games. When all slots are full for a position, registration will be closed and you will be placed on a wait-list.

Become a Cavalier

This luxury camp provides an excellent opportunity for 9th-12th-graders to be instructed by and compete in front of the UVA coaching staff, while also receiving the true UVA Player experience. This special camp is limited to only 35 campers, who will stay in the UVA First-Year Residence Halls, be given their own personalized locker, and will receive a game jersey, a game hat, and 2 authentic UVA T-shirts. Camp activities will consist of offensive/defensive skill sessions, pro-style workout, and games. Campers will receive an evaluation from the Virginia coaching staff as well as a DVD of their performance at camp. For a player who is looking to have the most hands on instruction and evaluation by our staff, this camp provides the best opportunity with great player to coach ratios and the most access to our teaching facilities.

Developmental Become a Cavalier

This 3-day overnight camp is open to players between the ages of 9 and 14. The camp provides a personalized experience with the Virginia Baseball Program as the camp has a limited roster to maximize the player's time with the coaching staff, current and former players. During the camp, players will each have their own locker in the locker room including a game jersey, two official UVA t-shirts and a game hat. The camp will include specialized instruction and games for the players. This is a great camp for young players looking to advance their game in a small camp setting. Players will be grouped by age.

Youth Developmental Camp

Open to players between the ages of 6 and 12, this day camp offers personal and group instruction in all phases of the game of baseball. Our knowledgeable and energetic staff will include UVA Coaches, current and former players. The staff will provide proper instruction and drills to enhance the skill level of each individual. Campers will be instructed in fundamentals including: hitting, pitching, infield, outfield, catching, base running, bunting, cut-offs & relays, rundowns, and sliding. Campers will be grouped by age in the camp. Games will be played to emphasize the techniques learned in daily instruction. This is a commuter camp only.

***Daily Schedule: Monday – Thursday 9am – 4pm

Developmental Camp

This 4-day overnight camp is open to players between the ages of 11 and 15. Our knowledgeable and energetic staff will include UVA coaches, current and former UVA players. The staff will provide campers with specialized instruction covering all phases of the game. Campers will be grouped by age. Games will be played to emphasize the techniques learned in daily instruction. The 11-15 year old age group is a critical period in a player's development. The skills developed during these years will serve as the foundation for future development in high school and beyond. Players will leave this camp with new skills and techniques to help take their game to the next level and begin to maximize their potential.

***Daily Schedule: Sunday 6pm– 9pm, Monday & Tuesday 9am – 9pm, Wednesday 9am – 12pm

***Camp is open to any and all entrants, limited only by number, age, grade level, and/or gender by NCAA rules.

Site & Facility



The setting for Atlantic Coast Camps is the nationally renowned Grounds of the University of Virginia, located in beautiful Charlottesville, Virginia. The on-field camps will take place using indoor facilities at Davenport Field. This state-of-the-art facility has been rated in the top 15 nationally for best college baseball venues and seats up to 5,074 Cavalier fans. The indoor hitting facility is equipped with three full batting cages, soft toss and tee areas, four pitching machines, and artificial turf flooring. In the Fall of 2017 Davenport Stadium underwent a 19 million dollar expansion that will be ready for camp this summer.

Overnight campers will reside in air-conditioned residence halls normally occupied by First-year undergraduate students of the University. The University dining halls will be available for meals during the day, and food will be catered at the stadium each night for dinner. Commuters will be provided lunch and dinner each day. Youth Campers will need to bring a bagged lunch. Every camper in attendance will be provided a UVA Baseball T-Shirt.
