

## **Atlee Little League Complex Rules and Regulations**

- No Alcoholic beverages
- No Pets (Service dogs are allowed with proper identification as such)
- No Tobacco products (this includes vaping products)
- No profanity or the use of abusive language
- All vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas. There will be no parking inside of the interior complex gates.
- All bikes, motorcycles, and mopeds must be parked in designated parking areas
- All games will be immediately suspended when there is lightening or thunder in the vicinity and everyone shall be directed to their vehicles for at least 20 minutes. Play will resume no sooner than 20 minutes after the lightening passes
- Scorer's boxes may be occupied only by the score keeper, one scoreboard operator, and league officials. Individuals in scoring tower may not direct any comments to players, coaches, or umpires unless in an official capacity.
- Batting cages are not to be climbed or swung on. Batting helmets must be used in the batting cages at all times. Only one coach and one batter may be inside cage at a time. Unless players are gathering baseballs.
- Warm up throwing shall be done in the outfield
- A heat index guideline is in place to limit player's exposure to excessive heat conditions. The board member on duty or tournament official will monitor conditions and make the determination if games will commence at the Atlee Little League complex. Activities will be suspended when the heat index is greater than or equal to 105 degrees which is consistent with VHSL Heat Guidelines
- Team Managers/Coaches will be asked to make sure that their dugout is free of trash and equipment at the completion of their game.

**Please remember that we are an all volunteer organization. We own our facilities and are 100% responsible for maintaining them. We ask for your support by placing all trash in the trash receptacles before leaving the complex.**
