

# **Baseball Majors Fall Rules Summary**

*\*\*All rules not referenced in this summary follow the 2023 Little League Baseball Rulebook\*\**

**Time Limit (Regular Season):** No new inning will start after one hour and forty-five minutes. All regular season games will have a two-hour drop dead time limit.

**Batting Lineup:** Continuous batting lineup will be used.

**Minimum Play:** Must play defensively at least every other inning.

**Run Limits:** 5 runs per inning limit.

**Number of Players:** A game may start or continue with only 8 players. When the 9th position comes up in the batting order, the position is skipped without penalty as long as it is vacated.

**Pitching Limits:** All Little League pitch-based rest requirements must be followed. In addition, no player may pitch more than 2 innings in one game.

**Courtesy Runner:** A courtesy runner may be used for the pitcher or catcher of record when there are two outs. The courtesy runner is the player in the lineup who made the last out.
